

Sebastian Jarzębowski, PhD, DSc, is an associate professor of the Institute of Agricultural and Food Economics – National Research Institute. He obtained a MSc degree in Economics and Social Sciences at the University of Bonn (2006) and conducted research under a joint PhD program in Economics at the same institution (2006-2009). His scientific and research activities focus on economics, supply chains and logistics, food safety, and the efficiency of companies and chains.

He is an author of several dozen publications, including international ones. In order to conduct research, he repeatedly visited the leading universities in Australia, Austria, France, Germany, and the USA, and was a visiting professor at Fisher College of Business, Ohio State University, USA, and the University of Bonn, Germany. Mr. Jarzębowski was awarded scholarships from Deutscher Akademischer Austauschdienst (DAAD), the Schaumann Foundation, and many others. He coordinated more than 20 domestic and international research and development (R&D) projects financed within programs, such as: Horizon 2020, Interreg, POWER, Human Capital Operational Program (PO KL), Regional Operational Program (RPO), FP7, the National Science Centre (NCN), the National Centre for Research and Development (NCBiR), in the field of chain and systems efficiency, in particular: supply chain integration, digital transformation, sustainability, and short supply chains.

Moreover, Mr. Jarzębowski is an Associate Editor, Guest Editor, Editorial Board Member and Reviewer at multiple leading journals.
