

Wioletta Wrzaszcz, PhD, has worked at the Institute of Agricultural and Food Economics – National Research Institute since 2005. In 2012, she obtained her doctoral degree in economic sciences. Since 2019, she has also been the coordinator of postgraduate studies at the IAFE-NRI. She currently works in the Department of Agricultural Economics, Agricultural Policy and Rural Development. Additionally, she is employed as an expert at Statistics Poland in the Department of Statistical Studies.

Her scientific interests revolve around the sustainable development of farms and agriculture, in particular environmental and economic issues of agricultural production. She is interested in measuring the sustainability of farms and agriculture based on data from the Farm Accountancy Data Network (FADN) and Statistics Poland. She is the author of about 80 scientific publications and several dozen expert opinions prepared mainly for the Ministry of Agriculture and Rural Development.

Since 2012, she has participated in national and international research projects. She is a member of various research teams and organizations, including national and European associations of agricultural economists (SERiA, EAAE), as well as expert teams appointed by the Ministry of Agriculture and Rural Development and the OECD (the OECD Network for Farm-Level Analysis; the OECD Network on Agricultural TFP and Environment). She is currently involved in several international projects under the Horizon 2020 program (MEF4CAP; COOPID, BioestUp). Since 2019, she has worked as the content editor of the scientific journal *Wiadomości Statystyczne. The Polish Statistician* published by Statistics Poland and the Polish Statistical Association.
