

**Iwona Szczepaniak**, PhD, DSc, is a professor of the Institute of Agricultural and Food Economics – National Research Institute (IAFE-NRI). She graduated from the Faculty of Economic Sciences at the University of Warsaw (1988) and obtained a PhD degree in economics (IAFE-NRI, 2007) and a postdoctoral degree in social sciences in the field of economics and finance (IAFE-NRI, 2020). Since 1988, she has been employed at the IAFE-NRI in the following positions: assistant, senior assistant, assistant professor, the head of Food Industry Economics Department (2008-2019) and the head of Agribusiness and Bioeconomy Department (from 2020). Between 1990 and 2002, she worked for the consulting company Business Analyses & Advisers Poland as an independent economic expert.

Her main scientific and research interests include: economics of the food processing industry, international competitiveness of Polish food sector, foreign trade of agri-food products, development of agricultural markets, evolution of the agri-food sector in the period of systemic transformation, Poland's membership in the European Union and globalization of the world economy, food losses and waste in the food chain.

On the scientific ground, professor Szczepaniak managed many tasks and research topics concerning the impact of the globalization processes and European integration on the transformation of the Polish food industry as well as international competitiveness of Polish food sector as part of the IAFE-NRI statutory activities, as well as Multi-Annual Programs.

She is the author and co-author of approx. 250 scientific publications and approx. 100 expert opinions for public administration bodies and food sector entities; participant in several national and foreign research projects. She also works as a postgraduate lecturer at the IAFE-NRI (subject: agribusiness economics).

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
